



Summary of Indoor Residual Spraying in Chad

AFM summarized indoor residual spraying (IRS) activities occurring in African countries based primarily on reports from the World Health Organization (WHO), Global Fund and the President's Malaria Initiative (PMI). Little information was available from other sources. AFM hopes IRS activities will be sustained and expanded as appropriate, and that all donor agencies supporting IRS with public funds will make available detailed and accurate reports in the future. Below is the summary of IRS activities in Chad.

A Round 7 Global Fund malaria grant has been awarded to Chad. According to the Original Proposal, support was requested for early detection and response to malaria epidemics in select districts through the training of IRS teams and the purchase of insecticides, pumps and protective kits.
